Title: Young cerebral palsy advocates campaigning to make school and work more accessible

Content:

A new group of young people with cerebral palsy are campaigning to make the pathways from school to work more accessible for people with disabilities.

The campaign is being run by the group of young people themselves and is supported by CPActive and the Cerebral Palsy Alliance.

The campaigners have started a petition, calling for an Inclusive School to Work Pathways Strategy for NSW.

They want this strategy to:

- Be designed by students with disability in partnership with educators, employers, and the community.
- Be consistent with Human Rights Obligations under the UNCRPD
- Include measurable targets that would be reported on annually
